

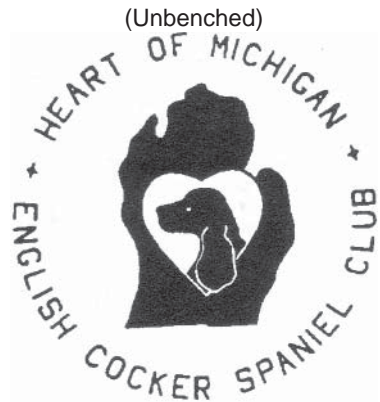

**NOTE: Bred-by-Exhibitor eligibility (revised 9/02):** All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be **individually registered with AKC**. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

- American-Bred Dogs
- Open Dogs - Parti-Color (To include roans, ticks)
- Open Dogs - Solid Color (To include any solid color, except white, with tan points)

**WINNERS DOG**

(Same Classes for Bitches)

**(Non-Regular Classes) Involving Single Dog Entries**

**Veteran Classes** - Class for Dogs and Class for Bitches 7 years of age and under 10 years and 10 years and older. (NOTE: Effective March 1, 1992, neutered dogs & spayed bitches are eligible to enter this class).

**Field Classes** - A class for dogs and a class for bitches that have earned Working Dog (WD) or Working Dog Excellent (WDX) titles from the English Cocker Spaniel Club of America or earned a Junior Hunter (JH), Senior Hunter (SH), Master Hunter (MH), Field Champion (FC) title or received a placement at an AKC Field Trial.

**Best of Breed Competition**

**Award of Merit** - one for every 50 dogs entered in the single entry breed classes at the specialty show, to be awarded to those dogs in the Best of Breed class *other than the dog or bitch that has been awarded Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed*, which, in the judge's opinion, best exemplify the breed's characteristics. Selected dogs will be given their award after Best of Breed judging, but before the judging of the non-regular multiple entry classes.

**Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries**

**Stud Dog Class** - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. Get only to be

judged based on it's merits. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class. An entry fee of \$28.00 will be charged for the Stud Dog if it is NOT entered in another class; \$20.00 fee as an Additional Class.

**Brood Bitch Class** - Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Note: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog Class or Brood Bitch Class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, not one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for the Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that a "castrated male may be entered as Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

**Brace Class** - Two dogs with Identical Ownership. Dogs may be entered for Brace Competition ONLY for \$14.00 per dog or, if the Brace Class is an Additional entry, the fee is \$20.00 for the Brace as a UNIT. The dogs comprising a Brace must be named at time of the entry. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for "Additional Classes" as Brace Class.

**Parade of Veterans** - Open to all English Cocker Spaniels 7 years of age and older. The Veteran may be entered in one of the regular or non-regular classes or for Best of Breed competition at the regular \$28.00 fee and the Parade of Veterans as an additional class for \$10.00 or for Parade of Veterans ONLY for \$10.00. Dogs entered for the Parade of Veterans only are required on the show grounds only at the time of the Parade. A Rosette with the dog's name inscribed will be presented to each entrant. "Parade of Veterans" must be marked on the entry form in the space for "Additional Classes" so that a rosette may be prepared. Please send a short paragraph about the Veteran to be read during the Parade when making the entry.
